SIMPLIFIED PRACTICE RECOMMENDATIONS

Revised to September 1, 1942

Simplified Practice means reduction of excessive variety of manufactured products, or of methods. Simplified Practice Recommendations are records of stock items retained after superfluous variety has been eliminated. These recommendations are developed by voluntary cooperation among manufacturers, distributors, consumers, and other interests, upon the initiative of any of these groups, through a regular procedure of the National Bureau of Standards established for that purpose. 1

With certain exceptions² current recommendations are available in printed form for 5 cents per copy, unless otherwise indicated. When ordering give number and title of the publication, as, for example, "R107-31, Glassine Bags."

A discount of 25 percent will be allowed on orders for 100 or more copies.
