Remittances should be made either by coupons (obtainable from the Superintendent of Documents in sets of 20 for \$1.00 and good until used), or by check or money order payable to the "Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, Washington 25, D. C.", and sent to him with order.

A discount of 25 percent will be allowed on orders for 100 or more copies.

Where "(E)" precedes the CS number, it indicates an emergency commercial standard, drafted under war conditions with a view toward early revision.

Those marked "OP" are out of print, but, in general, are mimeographed or may be consulted at technical libraries or many public libraries.

Mimeographed copies of Commercial Standards are available without charge, except those marked "NM" (Not Mimeographed), from the Division of Trade Standards, National Bureau of Standards, Washington 25, D. C. In a few cases, marked "MO", mimeographed copies only (no printed copies) are available.
