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CITY PLANNING COMMISSIONS IN THE UNITED STATES*

Introduction

At the close of the year 1932, official planning commissions or boards existed in 806 municipalities throughout the country, according to reports made to the Division of Building and Housing of the Department of Commerce. A tabulation of these municipalities, by states, with data in regard to the number of members, and terms of office, and other information is presented in the following pages.

A similar report made at the close of 1930 showed a total of such municipalities as 786, and a revised tabulation, at the end of 1931, showed 823. The 806 municipalities reported in the present tabulation, as a result of a survey of all incorporated places of over 10,000 population, represent a net increase of 20 since the issuance of the report covering the year 1930, and a decrease of 22 since the end of the year 1931. Although 45 municipalities which had not heretofore been reported as having planning commissions have been added to the list issued a year ago, this has been more than offset by 67 municipalities, previously reported as having official planning commissions, but which

have now been omitted from the tabulation as the commissions are not now in existence. Although in this survey no inquiry was made as to the cause of the discontinuance of these commissions, and in most cases no reason was given, some of the causes have been reported as: resignation of members with no reappointments; annexation of community to another city; opposition by local government or citizens to efforts of the commission; completion of work on zoning ordinances, which was the only function of the commission; abolition by city ordinance; discontinuance of appropriation; taking over of work by city officials and civic organizations; terms of members expired and no replacements; discharged upon commission's own request.

County or regional planning commissions or organizations are not included in this tabulation. A list of these bodies, both official and unofficial, now numbering 82, may be obtained from the Division of Building and Housing upon request.

In a number of counties and regions in which there are active county and regional planning organizations at work, there are many small local committees working in cooperation with the larger county or regional bodies. An example of this is in the New York region, where there are over 250 of these small groups, designated as local unofficial planning councils. Small committees of this kind are not included in this tabulation.

In the 806 municipalities listed there are included a small number of places in which the commission is a zoning commission with some planning responsibility other than zoning, or in which committees of the local governing bodies act in the capacity of a planning commission.

There are also listed herein 35 municipalities (in addition to the 806) which have been reported as having unofficial bodies or groups, usually appointed by the mayor or other administrative official, or representing local civic organizations or chambers of commerce, and functioning in an unofficial or wholly advisory capacity, rather than in an official capacity, in city planning matters.

In the total number of communities having official planning commissions or boards, as listed by States in the following pages, Massachusetts leads with 119; New York has 118; California, 100; Ohio, 79; Pennsylvania, 52; and Illinois, 41. The number recorded for each State appears in the summary on page 11.

In the table below, the 806 communities listed in this report are arranged in various population groups, together with the 1930 census figures for the total number of communities and total population in each group:

Effect of economic conditions

While in the course of this survey the division did not make any particular study of the effect of present economic conditions throughout the country upon the activities of city, town, and village planning commissions or boards, the groups engaged in this field of work have felt the adversities prevalent during the last two years. Although of the 806 municipalities listed in the tabulation, the planning boards of about 300 have indicated that there has been little or no change in the functions of their organizations within the last two years, over 100, about 50 of which represent the larger cities of the country, have reported that the functions of the planning commission have been curtailed.

The reason given in these cases has been the general economic conditions that have prevailed during the last two years. In at least 12 of the cities of more than 25,000 population, the services of important city planning engineers or other officials have been dispensed with, and in some cases the office staff has been reduced.

The question of curtailment

In times of depression, when cities find themselves pressed for funds on the one hand, and faced with the necessity of meeting emergency conditions on the other, it is natural for the governing body to eliminate or curtail as many of its functions and positions as possible. The function of a planning commission is, not only the development of the community along proper lines and providing adequately for its future growth, but in doing so to save the citizen and the taxpayer, in the long run, unnecessary expense. Many cases have been cited in which city planning commissions have brought about civic developments that have resulted in the saving to the taxpayers of many times the cost of the operation of the planning commission. The chairman of the Cincinnati Planning Commission, who is also the president of the National Conference on City Planning, is cited as having stated that nothing could be more wasteful than for cities to reduce their city planning budgets in the interests of economy.

In the report of January, 1933, of the special commission appointed by the legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to make a survey and study of the laws of that State relative to zoning and city planning, that commission states:

"City planning, however, has proved its worth fully as much for the small town as for the large city, and hundreds of industrial villages and land subdivisions and housing projects and developments of suburban road systems show, each in its own way, the economy and effectiveness gained by the use of the principles of city planning....."

"City planning, then, is a name for intelligence and economy in city arrangement. It pays, just as any foresight pays. It is, however, less easy to show in dollars and cents what has been gained when good planning has been done than it is to show what has been lost when planning has been neglected."

After listing some of the actual losses and wastes most plainly apparent in American cities, the commission further states:

"These losses and many others are the results of unregulated private initiative, and of lack of any consistent public policy as to uses of land; that is, they are due to lack of city planning. This commission believes that as a measure of economy there is nothing that the State can do which would cost so little and return so much as to encourage and guide progressive city planning.

"It is generally believed, and in many cases, specific figures have been held to prove, that good city planning, since it produces the effects above stated, is certainly reflected in greater taxable values and in lower tax rates."

It is believed that municipal governing bodies should exercise careful discrimination in the consideration of their budgets before reducing the efficiency of their planning com-

missions, inasmuch as such planning commissions may in reality be in themselves money-saving organizations. In many cases it will be found that such reductions bring about savings that are more apparent than real, and that curtailment in the necessary expenses of a commission may result in the abandonment or delay of development projects that would have resulted in conveniences and economies representing in dollars many times the amount of the apparent saving.

Functions of a planning commission

Among the functions of a planning commission is the task of preparing a general design of city, town, or village development so that such development may take place in a systematic, coordinated, and intelligently controlled manner. The matters to be covered by the design may properly be classed as dealing with streets, other types of public grounds, public buildings, public utilities, and the development of private property (zoning). It is believed that communities that have established planning commissions are better equipped than others to exercise foresight in working out such a plan or design, and to bring about economy in the development of the community through the control of street and subdivision layout, the location of parks and other open spaces, public works and utilities, and the regulation of the use of private property through zoning ordinances.

One of the desirable features of a plan that is well drawn and administered, is that it serves to assist public officials in the budgeting of capital expenditures over a period of years.

It also provides flexibility of execution, so that in times of emergency, public improvements may be expedited without the waste that often accompanies emergency measures. Likewise, when business and employment conditions indicate the wisdom of decreasing the amount of improvements, that may be done. So the plan may fit in with and control a long-range program designed to maintain, as nearly as possible, an economic balance in the municipality.

Distinction between planning and legislation

The study of, and guidance on, the foregoing subjects are functions of a planning commission. The functions of the city council, or the governing body of the municipality are, on the other hand, somewhat different. In pointing out the distinction between planning and legislation, the Advisory Committee on City Planning and Zoning of the Department of Commerce, appointed by the Secretary of Commerce and composed of leading men in this field, in the footnotes to its Standard City Planning Enabling Act* explains that planning is intended to be a process whereby the larger lines and directions of future public and private development will be influenced and to some extent controlled. should be designed to cover a long period of years, much longer than the term of office of any single city council. Legislation, on the other hand, is designed to meet pressing and immediate needs, whether it takes the form of penal legislation or fiscal legislation. Although the two functions, planning and legislation, are both important, and essential to the efficient working of city government, yet they are quite different from each other and involve different considerations, differing points of view and different talents and interests. The two functions, therefore, need to be reposed in two separate bodies.

A planning commission has the advantage of freedom from all municipal problems except those of planning. With long and overlapping terms of office its membership will eventually represent many years of planning experience. If authorized to contract with city planners, engineers, architects, and other consultants for such services as may be required, and by its cooperation with other municipal officials, a planning commission is better able to make a master plan than the governing body of the municipality. Each local governing body has the final determination as to the improvements to be made during its term, and an official master plan and the advice of an active planning commission will aid it greatly in making its decisions.

Explanatory note

In the accompanying tabulation the data shown have been obtained from the records of the Division of Building and Housing and from information obtained through the cooperation of city planning and zoning experts, municipal leagues, state, county and city officials, chairmen and members of local planning and zoning boards, and others. Occasional omissions appear in the tabulation, where the necessary data were not obtained. The division will appreciate being informed of any errors that may be found, of any commissions that should have been included or omitted, or of any new commissions that may be established from time to time.

Below is an explanation of the abbreviations and symbols used in the tabulation:

"x" is an affirmative check mark.

"Ov." means that terms of office overlap.

"Not" means that terms of office do not overlap.

"Indef." means that terms of office are not definitely fixed.

Cities having a population of over 25,000 (1930 Census) are underscored.
