Where the price is noted, the publication may be purchased from the Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, Washington, D. C. The prices quoted are for delivery to addresses in the United States and its possessions, and to Canada, Cuba, Mexico, Newfoundland, the Philippines, and the Republic of Panama. When remitting for delivery to countries other than those, include in your remittance one-third of the total cost of the publications to cover postage. Remittances should be made payable to the "Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, Washington, D. C." and sent to him with the order.

C = Circular of the National Bureau of Standards

RP = Research Papers of the National Bureau of Standards. These are reprints of articles appearing in the 'Bureau of Standards Journal of Research' (BS J. Research) and the 'Journal of Research of the National Bureau of Standards' (J. Research NBS), the latter being the title of this periodical since July, 1934 (volume 1, number 1).

M = Miscellaneous Publication of the National Bureau of Standards

BP = Building and Housing Publication of the National Bureau of Standards

CS = Commercial Standard of the National Bureau of Standards.

OP = Out of print. Papers which are out of print can usually be consulted at the leading libraries of the larger cities.
