GENERAL INFORMATION

Where the price is stated, the publication can be purchased from the Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, Washington, D. C. The prices quoted are for delivery to addresses in the United States and its territories and possessions and in certain foreign countries which extend the franking privilege. In the case of all other countries, one-third the cost of the publication should be added to cover postage. Remittances should be made either by coupons (obtainable from the Superintendent of Documents in sets of 20 for \$1.00 and good until used), or by check or money order payable to the "Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, Washington, D. C." and sent to him with order.

A discount of 25 percent will be allowed on orders for 100 or more copies.

Those marked "OP" are out of print, but, in general, are mimeographed or may be consulted at technical libraries or many public libraries.

Mimeographed copies of Commercial Standards are available without charge, except those marked NM (Not Mimeographed), from the Division of Trade Standards, National Bureau of Standards, Washington, D. C.
