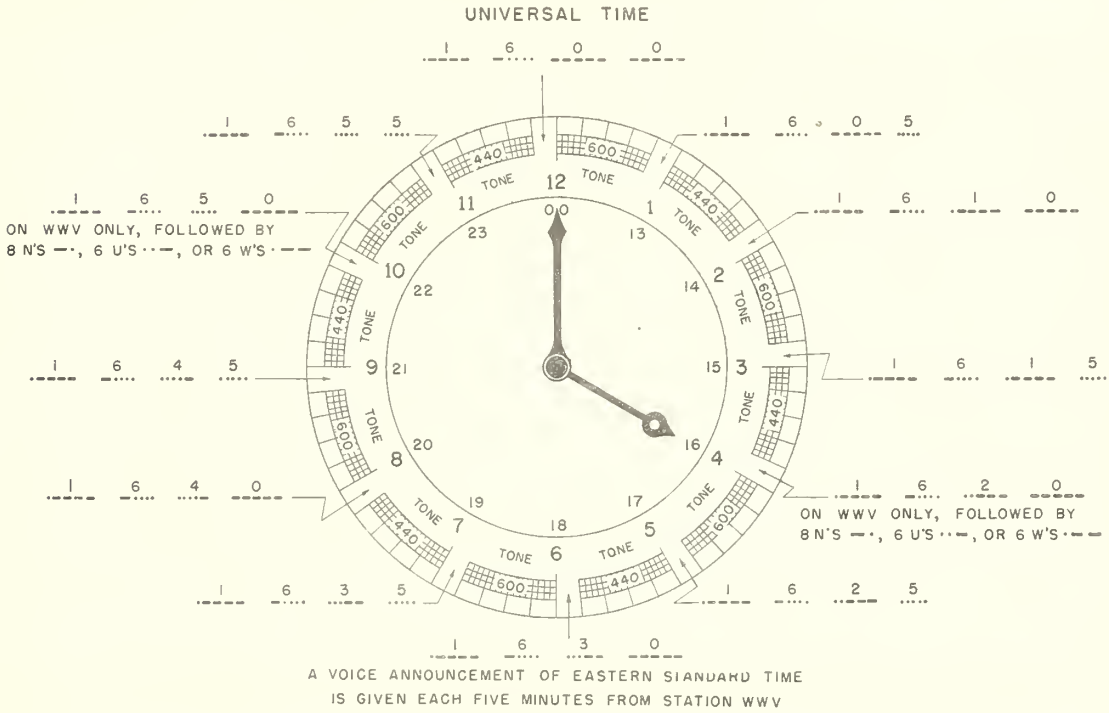

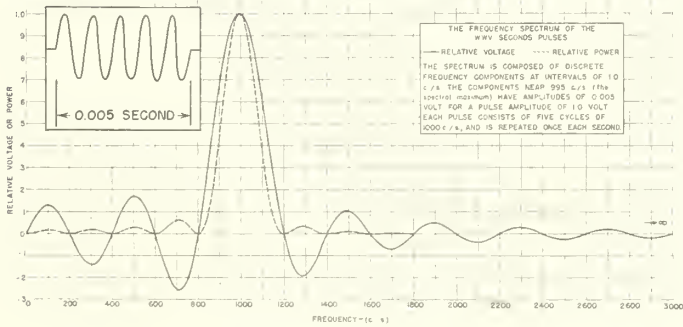

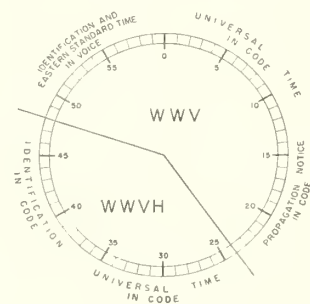


SECONDS PULSE

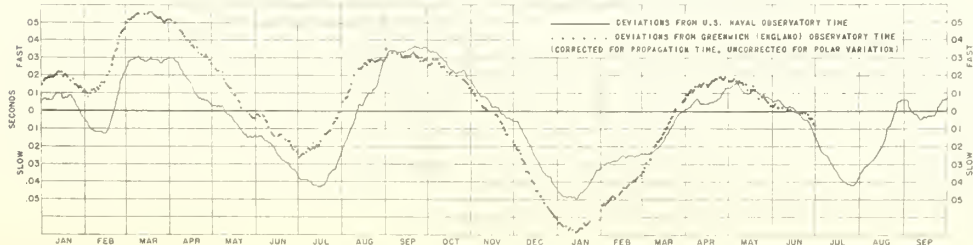
