The National Bureau of Standards¹ was established by an act of Congress on March 3, 1901. The Bureau's overall goal is to strengthen and advance the Nation's science and technology and facilitate their effective application for public benefit. To this end, the Bureau conducts research and provides: (1) a basis for the Nation's physical measurement system, (2) scientific and technological services for industry and government, (3) a technical basis for equity in trade, and (4) technical services to promote public safety. The Bureau's technical work is performed by the National Measurement Laboratory, the National Engineering Laboratory, and the Institute for Computer Sciences and Technology.

ABSTRACT

This report describes the GATT Standards Code activities performed by the Standards Code and Information program, National Bureau of Standards (NBS), for calendar year 1983. NBS responsibilities include operating the U.S. GATT inquiry point for information on standards and certification activities; notifying the GATT Secretariat of proposed U.S. Federal government standards-based rules that may significantly affect trade; assisting U.S. industry with trade-related standards problems; and responding to inquiries on foreign and U.S. proposed regulations.

Key Words: foreign proposed regulations; GATT Standards Code; notifications; standards information; technical assistance.



INTRODUCTION

The Office of Product Standards Policy (OPSP) has several responsibilities for implementing the international Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade (Standards Code) in the United States. The Code has been in effect since January 1, 1980 and is administered by the Secretariat of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT) in Geneva, Switzerland. There are currently 37 signatories^{1/} to the Code, 26 of which have actively implemented the code in their countries.

Title IV of the U.S. Trade Agreements Act of 1979 provides for the establishment of a U.S. inquiry point,^{2/} standards information center, and technical office for non-agricultural products. These functions are performed within OPSP's Standards Code and Information (SCI) program, as an extension of NBS' traditional standards-related activities. This report summarizes SCI's Standards Code activities for calendar year 1983.

INQUIRY POINT

Notifications

The Standards Code requires that signatories notify the GATT Secretariat of proposed mandatory government regulations and certification procedures that might significantly affect international trade. The Secretariat, in turn, issues notifications of these proposals and disseminates them to all signatories.

As the official GATT inquiry point for information on standards and certification activities, SCI notifies the Secretariat of proposed U.S. Federal Government rules that might significantly affect trade; receives foreign notifications and disseminates them to appropriate U.S. industries along with supplementary information; and responds to inquiries on both foreign and U.S. notifications. SCI's GATT notification activities are reported monthly to appropriate NBS managers and other Federal Government agencies concerned with the Code's implementation.^{3/}

2/ The Code requires that each signatory provide an inquiry point to answer all reasonable inquiries on technical regulations, standards and certification systems.

3/ International Trade Administration (Dept. of Commerce), Office of the U.S. Trade Representative (USTR), and the U.S. Departments of Agriculture and State.

The GATT Secretariat issued a total of 255 notifications in 1983. Twenty-two of the 37 signatories reported at least one proposed regulation (see Table 1). Japan had the most notifications with 92. About one-third of Japan's notifications dealt with the recent revision of 16 of their laws to improve access to Japanese certification procedures by foreign manufacturers. Seven other signatories - Canada, European Economic Community (EEC), Finland, Philippines, Sweden, United Kingdom and United States - reported 15 or more proposed regulations.

As soon as they are obtained from the Secretariat, the USTR office in Geneva cables the notifications (which include country, TBT/Notification number, brief description of the regulation and closing date for comments) to the United States. In order to provide wide access to this information in the United States, all foreign notifications are currently published in the Commerce Business Daily, the American National Standards Institute's ANSI Reporter, the Department of Agriculture's Export Briefs, and several other publications. SCI maintains a computerized data system of all GATT notifications and a telephone GATT hotline where up-to-date notification information can be obtained. The hotline number is (301) 921-3200.

Proposed U.S. Regulations

In 1983, 15 proposed U.S. regulations were reported. Notifications are based on U.S. Government rules (mandatory standards or certification systems) published in the Federal Register (FR). SCI staff regularly review the FR to identify those proposed regulations that might significantly affect trade. Notices are sent directly to the GATT Secretariat via telex.

The Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration had five of the 15 regulations reported in 1983. The number of notifications from each issuing agency is shown below. The regulations dealt with such products as motor vehicles, telecommunications equipment, food products, and heating equipment (see Table 2).

Proposed Foreign Regulations

The GATT Secretariat issued 240 notifications from countries other than the United States in 1983 (see Table 3).

The foreign regulations covered a wide variety of products, such as telecommunications equipment, food additives, electrical equipment, appliances and motor vehicles. The SCI inquiry point maintains a Key-Word-Out-Of-Context (KWOC) index on all products that are the subject of foreign notifications (see Appendix 1 for 1983 index) and keeps records of the names and addresses of individuals interested in specific products. When a notification concerning a particular product arrives, all individuals who have indicated an interest in that product are contacted.

Foreign notifications are sent regularly to the American National Standards Institute, Bureau of Industrial Economics (Department of Commerce), Industry Functional Advisory Committee (IFAC) members,^{4/} selected representatives on the Interagency Committee on Standards Policy (ICSP),^{5/} and several other groups and individuals for dissemination or publication.

Inquiries

In 1983, 458 letter or telephone requests for GATT notification information (405 U.S., 53 foreign) were processed. Many requestors asked for copies of more than one regulation. In addition to requests for specific regulations, many individuals asked for general information on the Standards Code. SCI responds to these individuals by sending an information package consisting of a list of recent foreign notifications, a brochure describing the Standards Code, ordering information for the Commerce Business Daily, and the latest issue of its newsletter, tbt news.

In 1983, U.S. exporters were most interested in regulations from Canada, Finland, the EEC, Japan, Sweden and the United Kingdom. The regulations most often requested concerned telecommunications equipment, chemical substances, appliances, electrical equipment, fire equipment and alarms, and foodstuffs. In addition, the GATT hotline received 591 calls.

Translations

SCI requests the texts of all proposed foreign regulations from the appropriate inquiry points. About half of the 240 regulations received in 1983 (123) were not in English. SCI has arranged for a translation service which can provide English translations of proposed foreign regulations. The cost of the translation is paid for by the requestor; if more than one request is received for the same translation, the cost is divided equally among the requestors. In 1983, SCI received four requests for translations of regulations.

^{4/} The IFAC advises the Department of Commerce and USTR on trade matters, the operation of any adopted trade agreements and other subjects related to U.S. trade policy. The members are representatives from private industry engaged in standards-related activities.

^{5/} ICSP consists of representatives from 24 Federal Government agencies who are concerned with facilitating the effective participation by the Federal Government in domestic and international standards activities and promoting the development of uniform policies among agencies participating in these activities.

Other Activities

In 1983, SCI began publication of tbt news, a newsletter intended to inform U.S. industry and other interested groups of the U.S. Government programs and activities in support of the Standards Code. Subscription to the newsletter is free and can be obtained by contacting the SCI office.

SCI staff participated in a meeting on procedures for information exchange held in May 1983 in Geneva, Switzerland. Representatives from GATT inquiry points met to discuss current activities, notification procedures, access to information, information needs, and problems encountered in obtaining information. Scheduled every 2 years and held in conjunction with the meeting of the Committee on Technical Barriers to Trade, this assembly of inquiry point representatives provides an opportunity to solve existing problems and to establish new procedures for more effective communication and information exchange. (The first such meeting was held in October 1981.)

STANDARDS INFORMATION

The National Center for Standards and Certification Information (NCSCI) is the national repository for standards documents. NCSCI supports the GATT inquiry point activities by supplying both domestic and foreign standards information. Established in 1965, NCSCI is designed to meet the needs of government, industry and the public for information on standards, regulations, certification programs and related activities that affect trade and commerce.

NCSCI's objectives are accomplished by maintaining a microform and hard copy collection of engineering standards and specifications, regulations, certification rules, directories, reference books and special publications. NCSCI staff respond to more than 5000 requests annually from all over the world on the existence, source and availability of standards and related documents. To the degree possible, NCSCI responds to trade-related queries regarding regulations and other requirements of foreign countries for the export of U.S. manufactured products.

In 1983 NCSCI developed in-house databases on certification organizations, foreign regulations, and reference materials (which complement an existing NCSCI computerized information system covering U.S. voluntary standards).

Other Activities

In 1983 NCSCI staff began updating An Index of U.S. Voluntary Engineering Standards (to replace NBS Special Publication 329) and has compiled a document entitled Standards Activities of Organizations in the United States, which will replace Directory of United States Standardization Activities (NBS SP417). The revised document will be printed in mid-1984. For additional information on NCSCI call (301) 921-2587.

TECHNICAL OFFICE

The SCI program performs the technical office functions for non-agricultural products. These include: a) providing assistance to U.S. exporters on specific technically based standards-related trade issues; b) assisting the International Trade Administration and Office of the U.S. Trade Representative in developing technical positions for bilateral and multilateral discussions; c) monitoring the level of U.S. participation in international standardization activities; d) participating in the Trade Policy Staff Committee's Subcommittee on Standards and the Industry Functional Advisory Committee; and e) serving as the focal point for information on international noise standards. Technical office staff also assist individuals in determining whether or not a proposed foreign regulation is consistent with current U.S. regulations/standards and international regulations/standards.

Assistance to Industry

Technical office staff work closely with industry representatives to solve standards-related trade problems. In 1983, the following organizations received assistance.

1. In its role as contact point for information on noise standards, the technical office assisted the Motor Vehicle Manufacturers Association in addressing a problem concerning motor vehicle noise. A working group of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UN/ECE) promulgated a draft resolution for automobiles which would have hampered U.S. automobile exports if adopted by UN/ECE member countries. Technical office staff worked with the association to compare the technical requirements of the proposed regulation with current U.S. automobile manufacturer practices. They jointly developed a proposal to accommodate the characteristics of U.S. vehicles under the UN/ECE technical requirements. The regulation was reassigned to the working group for further discussion.
2. Another item dealing with noise concerned an European Community (EC) directive on noise emission test procedures for earthmoving machinery. The Construction Industry Manufacturers Association (CIMA) felt the directive did not include acceptable specific noise levels and procedures for testing the noise emitted by the machinery. Technical office staff worked with CIMA to develop the technical positions to be presented at bilateral discussions on this subject with members of the EC.
3. The Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Institute and Association of Home Appliance Manufacturers have experienced a long-standing problem with respect to dual U.S. (Underwriters Laboratories) and Canadian (Canadian Standards Association) product requirements for household electrical appliances. A background paper, prepared by technical office staff, described the difficulties encountered by U.S. exporters and served as the basis for bilateral U.S.-Canada discussions on this subject.

4. Whittaker Corp., Survival Systems Division, had difficulties obtaining official approval in Denmark and Norway for their lifesaving equipment. The technical office provided information on U.S. Coast Guard approval practices which was used to resolve the problem.
5. Technical office staff also worked with U.S. manufacturers of compression chambers, forklifts and similar equipment, elevators and escalators, and communications equipment to develop a discussion paper for bilateral discussions with the Federal Republic of Germany.

Participation in meetings of industry representatives as well as interagency officials, provides technical office staff with the opportunity to discuss SCI programs and services, along with problems that may fall within the scope of SCI. In 1983, technical office staff participated in meetings of the Construction Industry Manufacturers Association, the 32nd annual meeting of the Standards Engineering Society, the Society of Automotive Engineers, Health Industry Manufacturers Association, and Educational Conference on Electrotechnical Standards serving on discussion panels and presenting invited papers.

Comment Handling

SCI assists organizations in developing comments on proposed foreign regulations which might create unnecessary trade barriers, and transmits all comments to the appropriate foreign government. Limited resources are available to assist U.S. companies in developing their comments and in determining whether a technical trade barrier exists. A major objective of the Standards Code is to enable exporters and government agencies to comment on foreign regulations which they feel would unjustifiably impede the export of U.S. products. In 1983, comments were made on 13 foreign regulations:

France - Construction Site Equipment (83.203 - .205)
EEC - Wheeled Agricultural and Forestry Tractors (83.126)
Japan - Glass Bottles for Carbonated Beverages (83.197)
Philippines - Steel Cylinder for Automotive LPG (83.9), Electrical Cartridge Fuses (83.10); Pneumatic Tires (83.14) and Internal Combustion Engines (83.15)
Sweden - Excavators (83.44) and Motorized Equipment and Tractors (83.182)
United Kingdom - Bridge-Connected Auxiliary Apparatus (83.173) and Series-Connected Auxiliary Apparatus (83.174)

Comment Periods

To provide signatories with adequate time to receive the text of a regulation (and to translate it if necessary), review it, and prepare comments, the Standards Code recommends a comment period of at least 45 days. If the comment period is insufficient (e.g. due to late receipt of an English version or complicated technical issues) the technical office will request from the issuing country an extension of the comment period. In 1983, eight requests were made, and granted.

The average length of the comment period^{6/} in 1983 was 41 days for U.S. regulations and 45 days for foreign regulations. Table 4 lists all U.S. regulations and the length of the comment period for each. The average length of comment period by U.S. agency was:

Comment periods for foreign regulations ranged from none at all to 132 days. Table 5 lists all foreign regulations for which notifications were received and the length of comment period for each. The average length of comment period by country was:

Reports and Studies

As part of SCI's interaction with other Federal Government agencies, technical office staff helped prepare a 3-year report describing the U.S.' implementation of the Code. The Report to the United States Congress on the Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade - "Standards Code" describes the activities of the four Government agencies principally involved in the Code's implementation. Limited copies are still available from the SCI office.

Directory of International and Regional Organizations Conducting Standards-Related Activities (NBS SP 649) was published in 1983. It lists 272 international and regional organizations which conduct standardization, certification, laboratory accreditation or other standards-related activities.

^{6/} Number of calendar days between the date the notification was issued by the GATT Secretariat and the closing date for comments.

Technical office staff completed an initial analysis of major areas of U.S. export trade and the degree of U.S. representation in international standards organizations which are open to U.S. participation. Summary statistics, based on available coarse-grained data, are useful indicators of the current level of effort. Another study was conducted to determine how a limited number of U.S. firms benefited by participating in international standards. A report summarizing the study results, Benefits Perceived by U.S. Industry from Participation in International Standards Activities, will be published in mid-1984.

Future Activities

The technical office staff plans to compare selected product regulations in several foreign countries to help exporters in getting through the standards and regulations maze. An analysis of Japanese agricultural equipment regulations and standards will be done in coordination with the Farm Industry and Equipment Institute. SCI will continue to work with U.S. industry to assist in solving standards-related trade problems.
