Introduction:

This Draft Standard for Trial Use contains the format and establishes the data contents of the Ship Notice/Manifest Transaction Set (856) for use within the context of an Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) environment. The transaction set can be used to list the contents of a shipment of goods as well as additional information relating to the shipment, such as order information, product description, physical characteristics, type of packaging, marking, carrier information, and configuration of goods within the transportation equipment. The transaction set enables the sender to describe the contents and configuration of a shipment in various levels of detail and provides an ordered flexibility to convey information. The sender of this transaction is the organization responsible for detailing and communicating the contents of a shipment, or shipments, to one or more receivers of the transaction set. The receiver of this transaction set can be any organization having an interest in the contents of a shipment or information about the contents of a shipment.

Notes:

1. Organizations use this transaction set to transmit shipment manifest information of luzardous waste being transported for disposal.

Subordinate/related uses of the transaction set include:

- a. Certify transfer/receipt of the waste to the generator and others as needed.
- b. Notify state environmental agencies of failure to receive certification/confirmation.
- c. Provide cradle-to-grave manifest audit trail information for disposal.
- d. Provide a summary report of waste imported into the United States.
- 2. Use a single occurrence of this transaction to transmit one or more line items on a single manifest or summary report.
- 3. This transaction set contains the data requirements to electronically transmit the Federal Uniform Hazardous Waste Manifest (UHWM) including continuation sheets.
- 4. Users may need to refer to the Shipment Container Conversion Table to cross reference X12 container codes to UHWM container types. This table can be found on the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) World Wide Web Site.

- The HL segment is used to identify levels of detail information using a hierarchical structure, such as relating line-item data to shipment data, and packaging data to line-item data.
- 2 HL01 shall contain a unique alphanumeric number for each occurrence of the HL segment in the transaction set. For example, HL01 could be used to indicate the number of occurrences of the HL segment, in which case the value of HL01 would be "1" for the initial HL segment and would be incremented by one in each subsequent HL segment within the transaction.
- 3 HL02 identifies the hierarchical ID number of the HL segment to which the current HL segment is subordinate.
- 4 HL03 indicates the context of the series of segments following the current HL segment up to the next occurrence of an HL segment in the transaction. For example, HL03 is used to indicate that subsequent segments in the HL loop form a logical grouping of data referring to shipment, order, or item-level information.
- 5 HL04 indicates whether or not there are subordinate (or child) HL segments related to the current HL segment.

Notes:

- 1. For manifests the transaction set hierarchical data structure is a single shipment handler information loop, followed by one or more line item detail loops, followed by any certification loop(s) as needed.
- 2. The single shipment handler loop iteration identifies the shipping and receiving organizations, transporter(s), and other associated organizations along with point of contact (POC) data for each organization.

Each 2/HL/010 line item loop iteration provides identification, quantity and other detail for one manifest line item. At least one line item iteration must exist for each manifest.

Each certification 2/HL/010 loop iteration provides certification detail including organization identification, certifying individual and PIN, and communications numbers.

One or more certification loop iterations must be used to report transfer/receipt of the waste as part of the EPA UHWM to the generator and state environmental organizations. They are not necessary when the transaction set is being used only to convey manifest data between automated systems.

3. For Foreign Waste Shipment Summaries, the transaction set hierarchical data structure is a single shipment handler loop, followed by one or more line item detail loops.

The single shipment handler loop iteration identifies the generating organization within the foreign country and the U.S. receiving organization.

Each 2/HL/010 line item loop iteration provides identification, quantity and other detail for one line item. At least one line item iteration must exist for each Foreign
